Of the 151 companies that received the NYC Comptroller and NYC Pension Funds' letter in 2017, 8 companies did not publish a proxy statement in 2020:

- 1 was acquired by a foreign company.
- 3 were acquired by another company that received the letter.
- 2 were acquired by a private company.
- 2 became private.






